RE: Asbestos AHERA Information Report

This is the annual updated compliance letter required by the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA). This act requires all school districts, public and private, grades K through 12, to inspect each of their school buildings for asbestos containing materials. Management plans have been developed outlining how asbestos containing materials will be handled in each of the school buildings.

Blackstone Valley Prep is committed to remaining a safe and healthy environment for all children, employees and guests in our schools. We will continue, as we have in the past, to monitor, inspect, and repair any asbestos containing materials. We intend to have our Asbestos Operations and Maintenance Program updated every six (6) months and shall notify occupants, in advance, if abatement will be performed within your school building. Unless an emergency arises, all asbestos abatement will be performed during the weekend or school holiday period.
